Test of Divisibility

1. Test of Divisibility by 6

A number is divisible by 6, it is divisible by each one of 2 and 3

For example Consider the number 75864.

Its unit digit is 4. So, it is divisible by 2.

Sum of its digits= $(7+5+8+6+4) = 30$, which is divisible by 3.

So, the given number is divisible by 3.

Thus, it is divisible by each one of 2 and 3

Hence, 75864 is divisible by 6

2. Test of Divisibility by 7

Step 1: Double the digit at ones place.

Step 2: Find the difference between the number obtained in step 1 and the number formed by the rest of its digits.

Step 3: If the number so obtained is divisible by 7, then the number is divisible by 7

For example Consider the number 6895.

Now, $689 - (2 \times 5) = (689 - 10) = 679$, which is divisible by 7

So, 6895 is divisible by 7.

3. Test of Divisibility by 8

A number is divisible by 8 if the number formed by its last 3 digits on its extreme right is divisible by 8

For example consider the number 53104

The number is formed by its last three digits is 104, which is divisible by 8.

So, 53104 is divisible by 8

4. Test of Divisibility by 9

A number is divisible by 9, if the sum of its digits is divisible by 9.

For example Consider the number 867105

Sum of its digits $= (8 + 6 + 7 + 1 + 0 + 5) = 27$, which is divisible by 9.

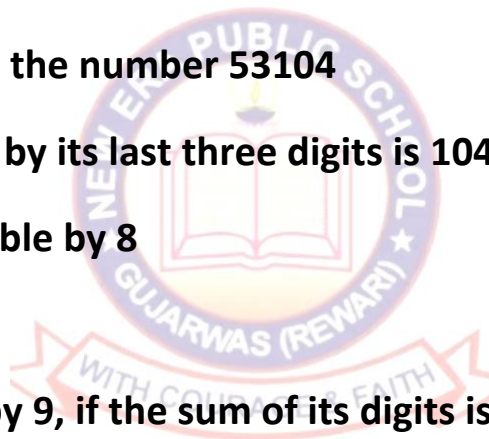
So, 867105 is divisible by 9.

4. Test of Divisibility by 10.

A number is divisible by 10 only when its unit digit is 0

For example Each of the number 540, 5910, 300 has 0 as its unit digit.

So, each one is divisible by 10.

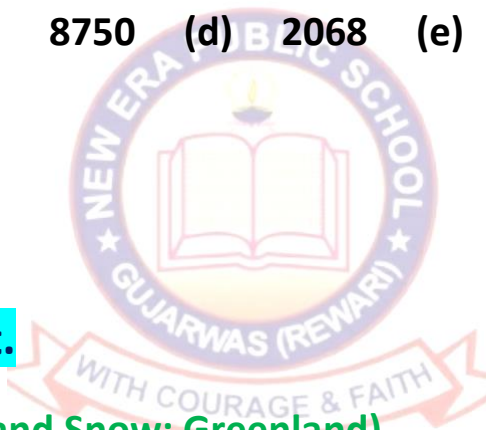

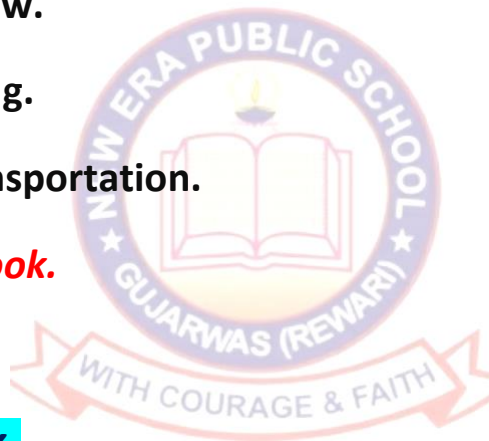
