In 8 digit numbers, clearly $15267302 < 15458314$

Clearly, the 9 digit number is the largest

1). Kangri-

A small earthen pot with burning coal used as a means to keep oneself warm.

2). The Northern Mountains include the Himalaya and the Karakoram mountain ranges, and the Purvachal Hill Ranges.

3). The Himalayas have three parallel ranges- Greater Himalaya, Middle Himalaya and Outer Himalaya.

4). The Northern Mountains cover the states of Jammu and Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Sikkim, Darjeeling in West Bengal and some part of Arunachal Pradesh. Most people are engaged in farming, sheep rearing and wood carving.

5). The Purvachal Hill Ranges cover Arunachal Pradesh, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram, Tripura and Meghalaya. Farming and Weaving are the main occupations.
