Numbers in Ascending order means the numbers from smaller to greater

Example : Arrange in an ascending order

3751234, 15267302, 143605217, 15458314, 4062341

Out of the given numbers two are 8 digit numbers and one is a 9 digit number

In 7 digit numbers, clearly. $3751234 < 4062341$

In 8 digit numbers, clearly $15267302 < 15458314$

Clearly, the 9 digit number is the largest

Hence, the given numbers in Ascending order are

3751234, 4062341, 15267302, 15458314, 143605217

Safety at home-

Most accidents occur at home due to our negligence. Observe the following safety rules to avoid them.

- 1 Keep your toys, books or other belongings on their proper place. Do not scatter them on the floor. They can hurt someone.
- 2 Never play on the stairs, terrace or other elevated place because falling down from there may cause severe injuries.
- 3 Never play with sharp objects like knife, blades etc. These can hurt and cause tetanus.
- 4 In case of gas leak, open all the doors and window of your home .Do not switch on lights.

Safety from fire-

Domestic fires and kitchen injuries are the most common example of accidents due to carelessness. We must follow certain safety rules for fire-

- 1 Do not play with fire.
- 2 In case of electrical short circuit or fire, switch off the main switch. Do not throw water.
- 3 Get all electric gadgets checked from time to time.
- 4 In case of fire caused by petrol, do not throw water, throw sand.



Types of Noun



There are four types of noun:

Common nouns: Words which give common names to persons, animals, places or things, which are of the same kind are called as **common noun**.

Examples: girl, boy, teacher, school, dog, cat etc.

Proper nouns: Words which give special names to a particular person, animal, place or thing are called **proper noun**.

Examples: Kunal, India, Delhi, Tommy, English etc.

Abstract nouns: An abstract noun is the name of some quality, feeling or idea. We can only think of it but cannot touch or see it.

Examples: happiness, truth, fear, joy, honesty, kindness etc.

Collective nouns: A noun that names a collection of persons, animals or things considered as one whole is a collective noun.

Examples:

a **fleet** of ships

a **String** of pearls

a **bunch** of keys

a **bundle** of sticks

a **bouquet** of flowers

In the above examples **fleet, string, bunch, bundle and bouquet** are the collective names of **ships, pearls, keys, sticks and flowers.**
