# 4 Claude Monet and the Haystack

Have you ever visited a museum of art? Do you know the name of any famous painter? Check the painter's work online at a museum website, such as the Museum of Modern Art. Draw and colour or paint your version of any of the paintings you like.

There is a silent letter in the word *Monet*. Which do you think it is? Check online and see if your guess is right.

Impressionism is a style of painting developed in the nineteenth century. It usually has quick, thick, and short brush strokes to capture the effects of light on objects.

The French painter Oscar-Claude Monet is known for creating a new style of art called **impressionism**. He was born in Paris in 1840. As a child, he spent a lot of time on the beach watching nature, such as the sky, the sea, and trees. He was influenced by what he saw in his childhood and began to represent his observations on the canvas.

One of Monet's observations was the effect that sunlight had when it fell on different objects. He tried very hard to capture the effect of light and shadow at different times of day and in different seasons. This led him to paint the same objects repeatedly. These paintings are called series paintings. His series paintings 'Haystacks (Effect of Snow and Sun)' are quite famous.

Monet came across **stacks** of hay during a casual walk in the fields near his house. He was fascinated by the effect of sunlight falling on the haystacks. He immediately asked his companion to bring his **palette** and canvas so that he could paint it. In one of his letters he

said, 'I am ... struggling with a series of different effects [haystacks] ... but at this season, the sun sets so fast I cannot follow it ... ' Between 1890 and 1891, Monet made about thirty paintings of the same haystack to capture the effects of nature.

**'Rouen Cathedral:** The Portal (Sunlight)' is another series of about thirty paintings. Monet took a year to paint them and another year to give the series its finishing touches. He would stand near the cathedral and move from one canvas to another to paint the effect of the shifting sunlight from one angle to another as the day progressed.

### Find Fraction Of a Fraction

For example  $1/2$  of  $1/4$

We define  $1/2$  of  $1/4 = 1/4 \times 1/2 = 1/8$

### Division of Fractions

### Multiplicative Inverse or Reciprocal of Numbers

If two numbers are such that their product is 1, then each is called the multiplicative inverse or reciprocal of the other.

For example we have,  $3/4 \times 4/3 = 3 \times 4 / 4 \times 3 = 1$

Reciprocal of  $3/4$  is  $4/3$ , and reciprocal of  $4/3$  is  $3/4$

### How to Write the Reciprocal of a Number?

To write the multiplicative inverse or the reciprocal of a fraction, we interchange the denominator and the numerator of that fraction.

For example Find the reciprocal of  $5/11$

The Reciprocal of  $5/11$  is  $11/5$




