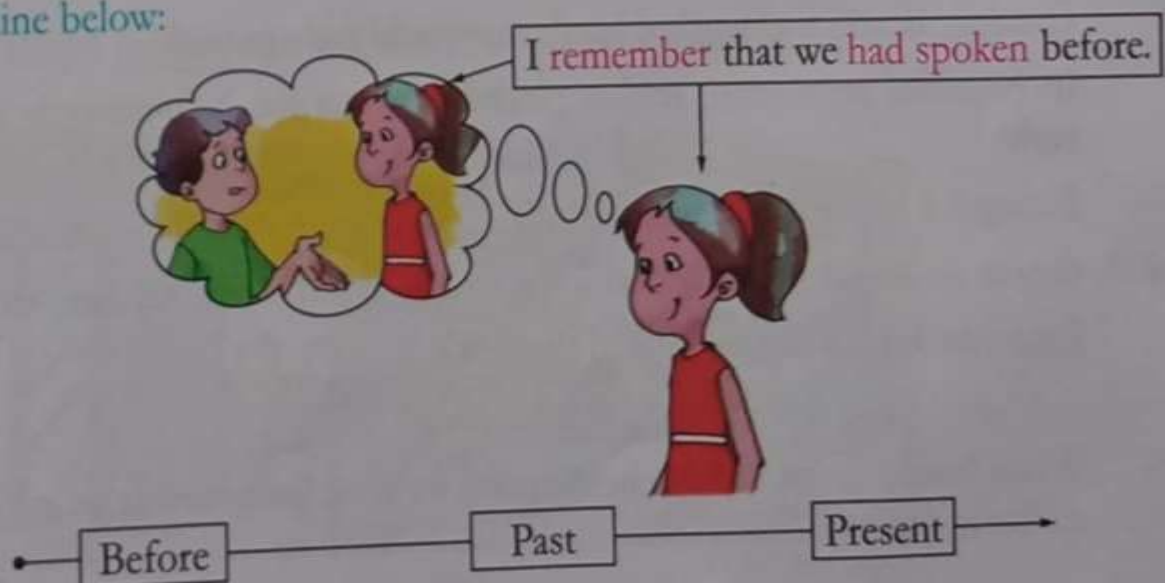


### 3. THE PAST PERFECT TENSE

The past perfect tense is used to sequentialise past actions. In other words, the past perfect tense helps us to distinguish between actions that have taken place in the near past and the ones that took place in the distant past.

Sentence Type	Sentence Structure	Examples
Affirmative (Yes-statement)	S + had + V <sup>3</sup> + Obj.	You <i>had played</i> the game.
Negative (No-statement)	S + hadn't + V <sup>3</sup> + Obj.	You <i>hadn't played</i> the game.
Interrogative (Yes/No question)	Had + S + V <sup>3</sup> + Obj. + ?	<i>Had you played</i> the game?
Interrogative (Wh-question)	Wh-word + had + S + V <sup>3</sup> + Obj. + ?	<i>What had you done?</i>
Interrogative negative (negative question)	Hadn't + S + V <sup>3</sup> + Obj. + ? Or Had + S + not + V <sup>3</sup> + Obj. + ?	Hadn't you <i>played</i> the game? Or Had you <i>not played</i> the game?
