Chapter-6 Types of Houses

**Q3. What are Pucca (Permanent) houses?**

**Ans.** Houses that are made up of stone, bricks, cement, steel, glass etc. are Pucca houses.

**Q.4 What are Kutcha (Temporary) houses?**

**Ans.** Houses that are made up of mud, wood, straw, cloth etc. are Kutcha houses.

**Q5. Name different types of temporary houses.**

**Ans.** Different types of temporary houses are hut, tent, houseboat, igloo, caravan, stilt house etc.

**Q6. Write difference between kutcha and pucca houses.**

**Ans.** Kutcha houses are made of mud, wood, straw while pucca houses are made of bricks, cement, steel, stone etc.
