Fractions in Lowest Terms or in Simplest Form

A fraction is said to be in lowest terms or in simplest form if the HCF of the numerator and the denominator is 1.

For example Show that the fraction $25/36$ is in the lowest terms.

The given fraction is $25/36$

The factors of 25 are 1,5,25

The factors of 36 are 1,2,3,4,6,9,12,18,36.

The common factor of 25 and 36 is 1 only,

HCF of 25 and 36 is 1

Hence, $25/36$ is in its lowest terms

How to Reduce a Fraction to its Lowest Terms or in Simplest Form?

Rule 1 To reduce a given fraction to its lowest terms, we divide the numerator and the denominator of the given fraction by their HCF

Rule 2 Divide the numerator and the denominator of the given fraction by their common factors till we are left with only the common factor 1

For example Reduce $18/24$ to its lowest terms.

Solution find the HCF of 18 and 24

Factor of 18 are 1,2,3,6,9,18

Factor of 24 are 1,2,3,4,6,8,12,24

Common factors of 18 and 24 are 1,2,3,6

HCF of 18 and 24=6

$18/24 = 18/24 \div 6/6 = 3/4$

Hence $18/24$ in its lowest terms is $3/4$
