### Fractions in Lowest Terms or in Simplest Form

A fraction is said to be in lowest terms or in simplest form if the HCF of the numerator and the denominator is 1.

For example Show that the fraction  $25/36$  is in the lowest terms.

The given fraction is  $25/36$

The factors of 25 are 1,5,25

The factors of 36 are 1,2,3,4,6,9,12,18,36.

The common factor of 25 and 36 is 1 only,

HCF of 25 and 36 is 1

Hence,  $25/36$  is in its lowest terms

How to Reduce a Fraction to its Lowest Terms or in Simplest Form?

**Rule 1** To reduce a given fraction to its lowest terms, we divide the numerator and the denominator of the given fraction by their HCF

**Rule 2** Divide the numerator and the denominator of the given fraction by their common factors till we are left with only the common factor 1

For example Reduce  $18/24$  to its lowest terms.

**Solution** find the HCF of 18 and 24

Factor of 18 are 1,2,3,6,9,18

Factor of 24 are 1,2,3,4,6,8,12,24

Common factors of 18 and 24 are 1,2,3,6

HCF of 18 and 24=6

$18/24 = 18/24 \div 6/6 = 3/4$

Hence  $18/24$  in its lowest terms is  $3/4$

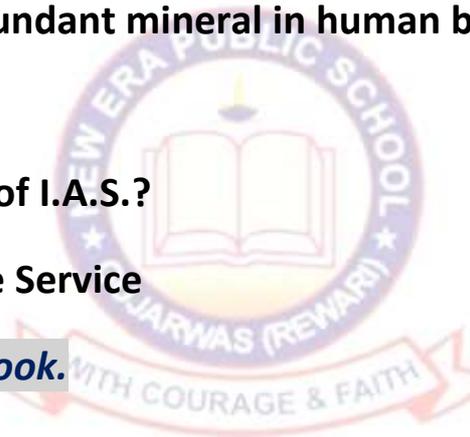
