Multiplicand X Multiplier = Product

9 X 7 = 63

Properties of Multiplication

1. Order property- The product of two numbers does not change if their order is changed.

Example- 3X10=30 and 10X3=30 So, 3X10=10X3

2. <u>Grouping property</u>- The product of three numbers does not change if their group is changed.

Example- (4X5) X2=20X2=40 and 4X (5X2)=4X10=40 So, (4X5) X2=4X (5X2)

3. <u>Multiplicative property of 1</u>- When we multiply a number by 1, then the product is always the number itself.

Example- 25X1=25 and 634X1=634

4. <u>Multiplicative property of 0</u>- When we multiply a number by 0, then the product is always 0.

Example- 18X0=0 3285X0=0


