

### Properties of Division

1. On division a non-zero number by, 1 the quotient is the number itself.

For example,  $86 \div 1 = 86$ ,  $619 \div 1 = 619$  etc.

2. On dividing a non-zero number by itself, the quotient obtained is 1.

For example,  $67 \div 67 = 1$ ,  $563 \div 563 = 1$  etc.

3. Division by zero has no meaning.

4. On dividing 0 by a non-zero number, the quotient obtained is 0

For example,  $0 \div 68 = 0$ ,  $0 \div 783 = 0$  etc.




