Addition of Unlike Fractions



When we add two or more unlike fractions, we follow the steps given below

Step: 1 Find the LCM of denominators of unlike fractions

Step: 2 Convert unlike fractions into equivalent like fractions with their LCM as common denominator.

Step 3 Add the like fractions so obtained

For example Find the addition of $\frac{3}{4}$ and $\frac{5}{6}$

Solution LCM of 4 and 6 = 12

Now, $\frac{3}{4} = \frac{3}{4} \times \frac{3}{3} = \frac{9}{12}$ and $\frac{5}{6} = \frac{5}{6} \times \frac{2}{2} = \frac{10}{12}$

So, $\frac{3}{4} + \frac{5}{6} = \frac{9}{12} + \frac{10}{12} = \frac{19}{12}$
