

Order of adjectives

Sometimes we use more than one adjective to describe a noun. However, we do not use these adjectives in any random order. We use a standard order in which the adjectives must follow.

Look at this flow chart to understand the order of adjectives.



Now read these examples.

- I saw a **big fat red** panda in the zoo.
- She bought **three beautiful Turkish** carpets.
- Zara keeps a **small square silk** handkerchief in her purse.



So we see that the order of adjectives is—

adjective of number → quality or opinion → size → age → shape
→ colour → nationality or origin → material → purpose

Properties of Factors

1. Every non zero number has a limited number of factors

For example, All the factors of 15 are 1,3,5,15

2. 1 is a factor of every number and it is the smallest factor of that number.

For example. (i) 1 is the smallest factor of 6

(ii) 1 is the smallest factor of 17

3. Every non zero number is the largest factor of itself.

For example. 16 is the largest factor of 16

4. Every non zero number is a factor of 0.

For example, 2 is a factor of 0; 3 is a factor of 0

5. We know that division by 0 is meaningless.

For example, 0 is not a factor of any number

6. Every factor of a non-zero number is either less than or equal to the given number

For example, All the factors of 20 are 1,2,4,5,10,20

Clearly, each one of them is less than or equal to 20


