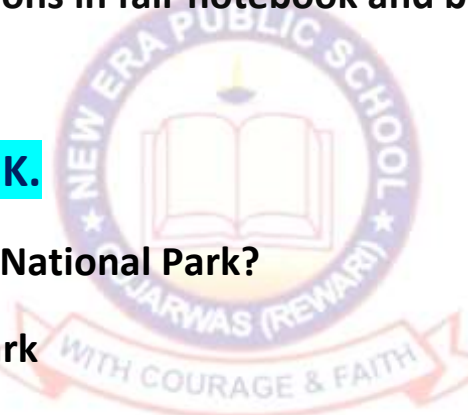

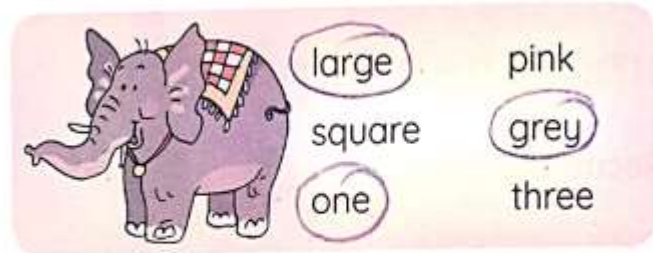
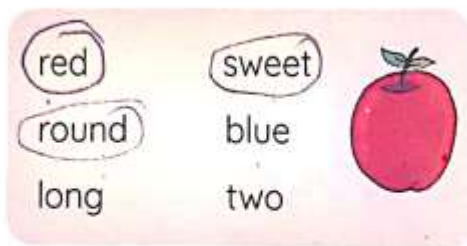


Describing words



Let's link it

A. Circle the words that tell us more about the apple and the elephant.



Apple and **elephant** are **naming words**. The words that you circled tell us more about these naming words.

- **red** apple
- **sweet** apple
- **grey** elephant
- **one** elephant

A word that tells us more about a naming word is called a **describing word**.

Colours, **numbers**, **shapes**, and **sizes** are **describing words**. For example—

- **blue** sky (colour)
- **round** ball (shape)
- **ten** fingers (number)
- **tall** tree (size)
