Q.3 Describe three degrees of comparison.

Ans. 1. Positive degree of adjectives- when no comparison is made. Ex. – Jaya is a tall girl.

2. Comparative degree of adjectives- when two persons, animals or things are compared. Ex – Riya is taller than Jaya.

3. Superlative degree of adjectives- when more than two persons, animals or things are compared. Ex – Joel is the tallest girl in the class.
