

Addition of Mixed Numerals

For example Find the sum of $3 \frac{2}{7}$ and $2 \frac{3}{7}$

$$\begin{array}{r} 2 \quad 3 \\ 3 \text{ ----} + 2 \text{ --} \\ 7 \quad 7 \end{array}$$

$$= \frac{23}{7} + \frac{17}{7} = \frac{40}{7}$$

Next example Find the sum of $1 \frac{3}{5} + 2 \frac{7}{10}$


