- (iii) For breeding purpose.


Arctic tern, Siberian crane, Salmon etc. are the examples of migratory animals.

Multiples

When a number divides another number exactly, then the dividend is called a multiple of the divisor.

For example, we know that 8 divides 32 exactly.

32 is a multiple of 8

We know that $7 \times 9 = 63$

63 is a multiple of each one of 7 and 9

Multiples of 2 are; 2,4,6,8,10,12,14,16,18,20,22,24.....

Multiples of 5 are; 5,10,15,20,25,30,35,40,45,50.....

First five multiples of 9 are 9,18,27,36,45.

Properties of multiples

1. every number is a multiple of 1

For example, $2=1 \times 2$, $3=1 \times 3$

2. every number is a multiple of itself.

For example, $4=4 \times 1$, $7=7 \times 1$ etc.


3. every non-zero multiple of a non-zero number is greater than or equal to the number.

For example, multiples of 2 are 2,4,6,8,10.....etc. and clearly, each one of them is equal to or greater than.

4 we can find as many multiples of a non-zero number as we want.

For example, multiples of 3 are 3,6,9,12,15, which are infinitely many.

5 0 is a multiple of every number.
